Role Overview

We are seeking a spiritually mature Lead Pastor who feels a calling from the Holy Spirit to lead our unique Spanish and English community. This role is a bridge-builder who can cast a unified vision while maintaining deep relational connections across generational and linguistic lines.

Vision & Strategic Priorities

The Lead Pastor will champion the following church goals and vision:

- **Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:** Prioritizing the spiritual health of the congregation. This includes calling people to become Christ followers and helping them to grow in that commitment.
 - **Intentional Cross-Cultural Connection:** Creating spaces where diverse cultures intersect and grow together.
 - **Study and Prayer:** Maintaining a high personal standard of spiritual discipline as the foundation for all other activities.
 - **Creative Engagement:** Leading the church into "non-traditional spaces" (community centers, local parks, digital spaces, etc.) to connect with those outside the four walls of the sanctuary alongside more traditional church engagement.

- **Teaching & Preaching:** Deliver variety in preaching, with a strong Bible exposition and theological soundness.
 - **Adaptability:** Demonstrate the ability to transition fluidly between languages and cultural contexts during services and ministry activities.
 - **Leadership:** Organize staff and volunteers to accomplish church events and Sunday Services. Lead collaboratively, balancing the responsibilities of authority with seeking consensus from others, including the elders and existing staff.
 - **Relational Care:** Prioritize empathy and hospitality, valuing the relational community as a core aspect of pastoral care.

- **Linguistic Proficiency:** Fluent bilingualism with the ability to adjust communication styles based on the audience. The ideal candidate will be able to preach and teach in English and Spanish.
